

# The **SAFER** model to applying public health principles to safety interventions

<b>S</b>	<b><u>S</u>ystem-wide approach</b>	Consider environments, not just individuals. What systems are at play that might be influenced or changed?
<b>A</b>	<b><u>A</u>ddress root causes</b>	Focus on the social determinants and underlying factors, not just symptoms.
<b>F</b>	<b><u>F</u>orm partnerships</b>	Work across sectors — schools, police, health, community — for collective impact.
<b>E</b>	<b><u>E</u>vidence and <u>e</u>valuation</b>	Base actions on data, measure and evaluate impact, and adapt.
<b>R</b>	<b><u>R</u>epresentation</b>	Design inclusively for all communities, especially marginalised ones.
