S	<u>S</u>ystem-wide approach	Consider environments, not just individuals. What systems are at play that might be influenced or changed?
A	<u>A</u>ddress root causes	Focus on the social determinants and underlying factors, not just symptoms.
F	<u>F</u>orm partnerships	Work across sectors — schools, police, health, community — for collective impact.
E	<u>E</u>vidence and <u>e</u>valuation	Base actions on data, measure and evaluate impact, and adapt.
R	<u>R</u>epresentation	Design inclusively for all communities, especially marginalised ones.
